Todd Steidley, UCO

-A UCO national champion and Hall of Famer, he has led the Bronchos to back-to-back NCAA Division II titles, five MIAA championships, and four Super Regional IV crowns. Before his time at UCO, he built a legendary high school coaching career, capturing seven state titles. Since taking over the Bronchos, he has amassed a 101-12 dual record, earned NWCA Coach of the Year honors, and mentored 36 All-Americans and eight national champions.

Scott Chenoweth, UCO

-A former Division I All-American and Hall of Fame coach, he has helped lead the Bronchos to two NCAA Division II national titles and four Super Regional IV championships. Before joining UCO, he built a dominant legacy as the head coach at Perry High School, where he won 12 state championships and 11 dual state titles while coaching 42 individual state champions and 118 state placers.

Tom Carr, OKWU

-Since taking over as head coach in 2020, he has brought experience from Central Christian and multiple NCAA programs. Committed to excellence and faith, he continues to build OKWU's wrestling program into a competitive force.

Joe Renfro, NEO

-A seven-time NJCAA Coach of the Year, he has led NEO to six national titles and 16 district championships. Since reviving the NEO wrestling program in 2013, he has coached 21 individual national champions and 123 All-Americans, continuing to lead this powerhouse program to success.

Bryan Kenney, Northern OK

-The head coach of Northern Oklahoma College's men's wrestling program, he brings extensive coaching experience, including 228 career dual wins across previous programs. Now, he aims to elevate NOC into a national contender.

Tyler Caldwell, OSU

-4x All-American, he is a key member of OSU's coaching staff, bringing elite experience as both a former athlete and coach. He helped support OSU to its 2025 Big 12 Championship finish. Previously the program's recruiting coordinator, Caldwell secured multiple top-ranked classes, including the nation's No. 1 overall recruits. A 2x NCAA finalist and Big 12 champion, he's been part of the Cowboy tradition for over a decade, now helping shape its future.

Teyon Ware, OU

-A two-time NCAA champion and four-time All-American for OU, he now serves as an assistant coach for the Sooners. With over a decade of coaching experience, including eight years at Wyoming, he has helped develop multiple All-Americans and Big 12 champions. An elite competitor in his own right, Ware went 132-0 in high school, earning four state titles and the prestigious Dave Schultz High School Excellence Award.

Matt Surber

-A Hall of Famer and legendary high school coach, Surber led Tuttle High School's wrestling program to unprecedented success over 14 years. Amassing a 192-15 dual record, he guided the team to 12 consecutive state tournament titles and 11 straight dual state championships. Under his leadership, Tuttle set a state scoring record with 247 team points and crowned nine individual state champions in the 2019-20 season. Throughout his tenure, he coached 139 state placers, 106 state finalists, and 65 individual state champions.



-Hall of fame legendary coach, led El Reno High School to 10 consecutive dual state championships and 11 team tournament titles; he coached 55 state champions and 56 state placers. At Oklahoma City University, he established both men's and women's wrestling programs, leading the women to 9 national titles and the men to top national finishes; individually he coached over 30 national champions and 100 All Americans. Randall's coaching excellence is nationally recognized, earning multiple Coach of the Year awards, including seven from the Oklahoma Coaches Association, plus national honors in USA Wrestling.

- Safety glasses and hearing protection required in all shooting areas (not provided). Gun actions must be kept open and unloaded except within the shooting stations.
- Ammunition shot size must be $7 \frac{1}{2}$, 8 or 9 and not over $1 \frac{1}{8}$ ounces. Carry shotguns with the muzzle either pointed up or down.
- OKUSA Wrestling reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program, refuse entry or cause withdrawal of any shooter or team, if conditions warrant.
- · No alcohol prior to or during shooting event.
